Learner funding and monitoring (FAM) type

- In June 2020 the government announced £1 billion of funding to support children and young people to catch up on missed learning caused by coronavirus (COVID19).
- Delivered via
 - Catch-up premium paid to schools last year only
 - National Tutoring Programme to provide additional, targeted support for those children and young people who need the most help

Learner funding and monitoring

Learner funding and monitoring (FAM) type

- There are three routes schools can choose from to deliver the National Tutoring Programme
 - Route 1: Tuition Partners
 - Route 2: Academic Mentors
 - Route 3: School-Led Tutoring
- The DfE are asking schools to record which pupils are receiving the extra support through School-Led Tutoring via the School Census




Learner funding and monitoring (FAM) type


- Oct 21
 - Record which pupils are <u>receiving</u> tutoring
- Jan 22
 - Record how many hours of tutoring each pupil has received in total between the beginning of September and census day in January
- May 22
 - Record how many hours of tutoring each pupil has received in total between the beginning of September and census day in May





SIMS Interventions


What are Interventions?



Interventions are anything that you are doing in school to help your students, above and beyond what would be considered part of normal school life.




This could be anything from academic catch ups, to work with students to improve attendance, to pastoral support, to ways to support students with behavioural issues, to support for pupil premium students.



Where are interventions in SIMS?

- Interventions are built into the SIMS core system, which means that you won't need to access any new systems
- To access Interventions, log into SIMS, then follow the menu route: Focus | Interventions | Plan Intervention



In addition to recording the School Led Tutoring, you will probably already have 'interventions' taking place, in school that you might want to record.

These steps will help you enter this information into the SIMS Interventions module so that you can later track their success.


- On this screen there are two sections (panels):






