Governor Hub

In case you missed it last time, we are pleased to announce that you can now purchase annual membership to Governor Hub through BESST at the discounted rate of £145 (excl VAT) per board for the academic year 22/23. We also plan to be able to offer discounted access to The Key by September.

GovernorHub is a secure solution for storing your governing board's documents, as a well as providing a shared calendar for meetings, a library of resources and more. Your bursar or headteacher can order your GovernorHub membership via the <u>online shop</u>.

Don't forget to renew your NGA Membership

This year, all maintained schools' governing boards in Bucks have had access to NGA standard membership and to over 50 e-learning modules paid for by Buckinghamshire Council. Next year, this same level of membership will be subsidised by the council at 50%. Discounted memberships at standard and gold level, and access to learning link for maintained schools and academies can be purchased through <u>BESST</u> via the online shop. BESST Governor Training for 22/23

BESST are growing our training for governors during 22/23 and we will be offering at least 8 live online evening sessions per half term throughout the year. Training packages can be purchased via the online shop, or you can opt for pay as you go.

The first autumn half term will include a free Governor Priorities Briefing session – ideal for helping to set your autumn term agendas; courses for new governors such as an introduction to schools' finance, an introduction to safeguarding and Being Strategic – what good governance looks like; as well as courses for more experienced governors, such as Strategic Financial Management, Managing Head teachers' performance and preparing for an Ofsted inspection.
